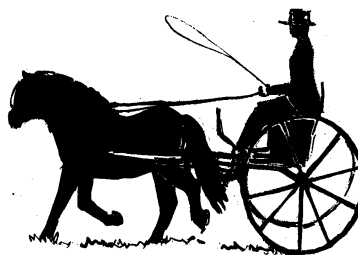
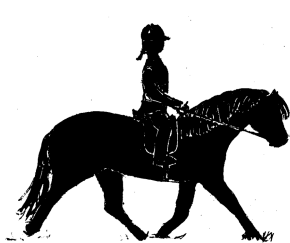

## Rules & Conditions

- 1 The show is run in accordance with the Bye-Laws of the Dartmoor Pony Society as amended/updated by Council.
- 2 No Member/Competitor/Exhibitor may knowingly show a pony in a class where the Judge has owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced that pony or where the pony has been owned, bred, sold, leased, broken, trained or produced by the Judge's immediate family (husband, wife, parents, children, brother or sister) partner, employer or employee. An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced, broken or trained an equine since 1<sup>st</sup> October in the previous year.
- 3 Please note that apart from the Gymkhana Classes, all ponies must be pure bred Dartmoor ponies registered in the main body of the Dartmoor Pony Society stud book or SR1 or SR2 registered ponies or be on the partbred register. The registration number must be on the entry form. Heritage Trust ponies will be eligible to enter Gymkhana Classes on production of a relevant passport.
- 4 No substitution of exhibits to be permitted
- 5 Owners must be members of the Dartmoor Pony Society to receive a DPS Rosette and must produce their current membership card in the ring at the time of the award. **The Owner or Lessee is the person in whose name the pony is registered in the DPS Stud Book.**
- 6 All stallions & colts three years old & over must be in possession of either a Ministry of Agriculture Licence, a Dartmoor Pony Society veterinary certificate or a Dartmoor Pony Society Veterinary Licence. All riders of stallions must have attained their 11th birthday by the 1st January in the current year in order to compete in all classes. All handlers of stallions & colts must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
- 7 Any person wishing to lodge a protest with reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the termination of the class, & at the same time shall deposit a sum of £50.00. If on investigation by the committee the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited.
- 8 Classes 3 to 18 will all be run under NPS Rules.

### **All ponies in Open Leading Rein Class must be shown in one of the snaffle bridles.**

- 9 A correctly secured skull cap/riding hat no. BS 4472, PAS 015, EN 1384 or BS 6473 must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 10 No spurs to be worn in any ridden class.
- 11 Numbers are to be collected on the day.
- 12 **Prizes:-**  
**Newoak Stud Championship-£100-very kindly sponsored by Joyce and Jackie Newbery**  
**This Championship is for the Champion Pony that has competed and been placed in 3 different elements of the show.**
- 13 **All trophies must be collected from the secretary on show day; they will not be posted after the show.**  
All trophies are the property of the DPPS. & are awarded annually. They should be engraved, cleaned & returned to the Trophy Secretary, Mrs Elizabeth Brewington, Dural Farm, Bradworthy, HOLSWORTHY, Devon, EX22 7RA by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2011, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Trophy Secretary to return trophies on the day the show **before 8.30 am otherwise they should be posted in advance.**
- 4 It is an offence to tie a pony to the outside of a trailer, wagon or any other structure unless attended by an adult at all times.
- 15 It is an offence to have ponies corralled anywhere on the show field.
- 16 The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries are received.
- 17 The Owner/handler of any animal deemed to be out of control may be asked to remove the animal from the show ground.

**Stabling will be available; £20.00 for the first night and £15.00 for the second day-including bedding (cardboard)**

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> August 2011.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Judges and/or stewards will check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Standard members will be required to upgrade to Full membership to enter the final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

## **Home Produced Ridden National Championship – Rosettes Direct O-HPR**

The NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden National Championship

a) This championship is for Home Produced ridden stallions, mares and geldings.

Ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. Ponies shown in these classes must be produced and shown by the owner/spouse or his/her Immediate Family. Please see the definition of Home Produced in section A 3.6. **Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.**

Qualifying rounds for this competition are run in conjunction with other NPS open ridden classes. Riders of eligible ponies must wear a white arm band to indicate their Home Produced status.

This competition is run in conjunction with the following NPS competitions:

M&M Open Ridden National Championship	- MM-OR
M&M Young Ridden Pony 2010 National Championship	- MM-4/5/6R
M&M Junior Ridden National Championship	- MM-JR
M&M First Ridden National Championship	- MM-FR
M&M Leading Rein National Championship	- MM-LR

Ponies to comply with the rules for the class originally entered.

- b) Rider's age to comply with the rules of the class originally entered.
- c) The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition but only ponies owned by NPS members can qualify for the final.
- d) The highest placed pony in each class, owned by an NPS member and ridden by a person wearing a white arm band qualifies for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line, which is owned by an NPS member and ridden by a person wearing a white arm band, receives the qualification. (NB. At the final qualifiers from the MM-OR and MM-4/5/6R will be combined into a single class).

### **Dartmoor Pony Society (DPS)**

A DPS rosette will be awarded to the Champion in the Ridden classes, the Champion WHP, the Champion Dressage and the Champion Driving, providing the pony is owned by a current member of the Dartmoor Pony Society. A current DPS Membership Card must be produced in the ring.

DPS Trophies will only be presented to current members. If the Championship winner is not a member they can elect to join on the day, otherwise the trophy will be presented to the Reserve Champion, if a member. If neither the Champion nor Reserve is a member (or does not become a member on the day), the trophy will not be presented.

There will be a lunch break from approximately 1pm until 2pm.

### **RING 1- 9.30 a.m.**

#### **Class 1 Veteran Open Ridden.**

This class is open to registered Dartmoor stallions, mares or geldings 15 years and over.

#### **Class 2 Partbred Open Ridden.**

This class is open to registered Part bred Dartmoor stallions, mares or geldings.

#### **Class 3 The NPS / Vale (UK) Ltd M&M Novice Leading Rein National Championship (MM-NLR)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Micor Demolition M&M Leading Rein final before 1st January in current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

#### **Class 4 The NPS / Simpson Refractories M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship (MM-NFR)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings four years old or over. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. The pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Micor Demolition M&M First Ridden Final before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year.

#### **Class 5 The NPS / Micor Demolition Ltd M&M Leading Rein National Championship (MM-LR)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

NPS /Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship- wear white arm bands.

**Class 6 The NPS / Micor Demolition Ltd M& M First Ridden National Championship (MM-FR)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings four years old or over. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but not reached their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands.

**Class 7 The NPS / Picton M&M Novice Ridden National Championship (MM-NR)**

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
  - ii) Won a class at an Olympia, HOYS or RIHS qualifying round
  - iii) Qualified for HOYS or RIHS Ridden classes
  - iv) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show
  - v) Qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Olympia in previous years
- Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

**Class 8 The NPS / R H R Demolition Ltd M&M Junior Ridden National Championship (MM-JR)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings four years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands.

**Class 9 The NPS / Peasedown Stud M&M Intermediate Ridden National Championship (MM-IR)**

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over. A pony is not eligible to compete if it has qualified before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year for The M&M Ridden Championship final at HOYS. or Olympia.

**Class 10 The NPS/Dargarvel M&M 4, 5 & 6 Year Old Ridden National Championship (MM-4/5/6R)**

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings four, five or six years old NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands.

**Class 11 The NPS/Ringside Stud M&M Open Ridden National Championship (MM-OR)**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over. NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship – wear white arm bands

**Followed by the L/R Championship from classes 3,5, 19 and 21.**

**Novice Championship from classes 3,4 and 7**

**Open Ridden Championship and NPS Silver Medal from classes 7, 8,9, 10 and 11.**

**Supreme Championship from Champions and Reserve from L/R, Novice, Open and WHP.**

## **WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES (WHP)**

### **Class 12 The NPS/Area XI M&M First Ridden Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-FRWHP)**

Open to registered Dartmoor mares or geldings four years old or over. Riders must have attained their 5th birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Riders who have qualified for the (HOYS/RIHS) M&M Working Hunter Pony Championship before the 1st January in the current year are not eligible.

### **Class 13 The NPS/Mrs M Alford's M&M Junior Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-JWHP)**

Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

### **Class 14 The NPS/Leyhills Working Hunter Pony Starter Stakes National Championship (MM-SSWHP)**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. Rider any age except stallions (see NPS rules) Pony never to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an open affiliated WHP class (all Societies). If a pony qualifies for any open affiliated WHP class it may not compete in the final of this competition.

Riders who have been placed at HOYS/RIHS WHP Finals may not compete

### **Class 15 The NPS / The Bowling Family M&M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-NWHP)**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open NPS affiliated M&M WHP class
- ii) Won a class at an M&M WHP (HOYS or RIHS) qualifying round
- iii) Qualified for the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show
- iv) Qualified for an M&M WHP final at HOYS or RIHS in previous years or in the current year.

### **Class 16 The NPS/KBIS M&M Intermediate Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-IWHP)**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over. Ponies never to have qualified for the NPS M&M Working Hunter Pony (HOYS/RIHS) finals before 1st January in the current year. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

### **Class 17 The NPS / Area 25 M&M Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-WHP)**

Open to registered pure bred Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over

**Class 18 The NPS/Prestige Browbands Competition Pony Ridden National Championship (O-COMP)**

Open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over registered in the main body of the Dartmoor stud books. Part bred are eligible provided they are registered in the Dartmoor Pony Society Stud Book.

Rider any age except stallions (see NPS rules). Pony to be shown in any suitable bridle, boots are not permitted. This competition will be judged in three phases

Phase 1 Freestyle show of a maximum of 2 minutes with compulsory elements (to include a rein back, walk on a long rein, three loop canter serpentine with a change of lead, canter extension, lengthened stride at the trot and walk to halt) – 40 marks

Phase 2 Jumping element – three fences – marks for approach, take off, landing – 40 marks

Phase 3 Conformation – 20 marks

**Followed by the Overall WHP Championship.**

**The winner to receive the WHP Trophy.**
