

Rules for Stallion of the Year (Hisley Salver), Mare of the Year (Hisley Salver) and Points for Youngster of the Year

Some rules for these points cups have been revised for 2003 and beyond.

- 1) Points are awarded for wins at major (ie Star Rosette) shows. No other shows to count.
- 2) Points are awarded as follows:-
 - a) 3, 2, 1, points for 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively in the Open stallion, mare and youngstock classes. But no pony may win points in more than one Open class at any show, so if shown in more than one class only the best result will be counted. Open Novice classes (ie with no restriction on owners) will now be included.
 - b) Breed Champion = 3 points Reserve Breed Champion = 2 points

At the Dartmoor Championship Show, the Northern Dartmoor Show and the Southern Dartmoor show only:-

the Male Champion, Female Champion, and Youngstock Champion = 2 points each and the Reserve Male, Female and Youngstock Champions = 1 point each

c) 3 Extra points for an Inter Breed Championship (i.e. Mountain and Moorland Champion or Cuddy Champion) and 2 Extra points for a Reserve Inter Breed Championship.

Inter-Breed Championships open to all other M&M breeds = 3 points

Reserve Inter-Breed Championships as above = 2 points

- 3) Where there is no separate 2 and 3 year old colt class, points won in the Open stallion class are transferred to the Youngstock section.

Sire of the Year

Based on points awarded to the Stallion's off spring

Points to be awarded at Major Shows (Star Rosette shows only).

No points for foal classes.

1st = 3 points If only 2 ponies in class, 1st = 2 points

2nd = 2 points If only 2 ponies in class, 2nd = 1 points

3rd = 1 points If only 1 pony in class, 1st = 1 point

If a pony placed in classes of 1 or 2 ponies then goes on to be Champion or Reserve Champion, full points will be awarded for the class.

Breed Champion = 2 points Reserve Champion = 1 point

Breed Show Supremes only: Champion = 4 points Reserve Champion = 3 points

Championships with the Breed Classes which qualify for points are Male, Female, Youngstock Champions only.

Champion = 3 points Reserve Champion = 2 points

Inter Breed Championships must be all to ALL other Mountain and Moorland Breeds to gain points.

Champion = 3 points Reserve Champion = 2 points

Novice Classes Open novice (i.e. no restriction on owner) classes to be included but only one class per show to count, that is, highest place in either Open or Novice to count.

Additional points for Sire of the Year

Open Breed Ridden only 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point

NPS M&M Ridden (Olympia)- Champion = 3 points, Reserve Champion = 2 points

HOYS In-hand Championship - Champion = 3 points, Reserve Champion = 2 points

HOYS Ridden M&M - Champion = 2 points, Reserve Champion = 1 point

HOYS NPS M&M WHP - Champion = 2 points, Reserve Champion = 1 point

Dartmoor Performance Award (TopSpec) - Champion = 2 points, Reserve = 1 point.
